Meeting of the Board of Trustees February 10, 2022 2:00 p.m.

 <u>Call to Order</u>. The Board of Trustees conducted its January 2022 monthly Board meeting on February 10, 2022 at the Trinity River Campus, with Ms. Teresa Ayala presiding. Other Trustees present were Mr. Kenneth Barr, Mr. William Greenhill, Dr. Gwendolyn Morrison, Ms. Shannon Wood and Ms. Jeannie Deakyne. Also present were Chancellor Giovannini and members of the TCCD staff.

6. Monthly Financial Report Information.

Chief Operating Officer Susan Alanis reported the financials as follows for December 2021. Total income is at 37.3 percent, total expenses is at 35.8 percent. Pools increased by \$44.9 million. No Treasury Bills activity in December. Total Portfolio increased by \$34.5 million during December to an ending balance of \$715.7 million. Yield was 0.36 percent at December 31, 2021 and the WAM was at 73 days. Mallory Sampson and Nelson Bush provided an Investment Report update.

7. Chancellor's Report Information.

a. College Accolades

Dr. Giovannini presented the board with the many accolades at Tarrant County College featured in their board packets. Chancellor provided an update of the enrollment of colleges in the past two years, especially enrollment of students of color nationwide. The good news is that TCCD is the in the top 25 community colleges for Hispanic students. Dr. Giovannini provided a snapshot of the census data that compared enrollment from fall to spring. The census data shows that spring enrollment has increased to a little over 3 percent. The spring census data for spring 2022 is greater than the end of term data for fall 2021.
