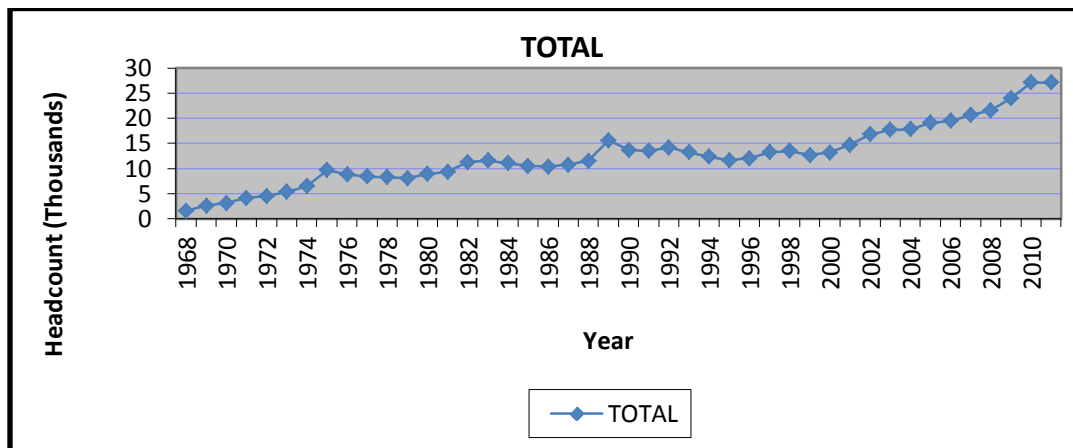

**Minor differences are to be expected between the data in this section and the certified state reports.**

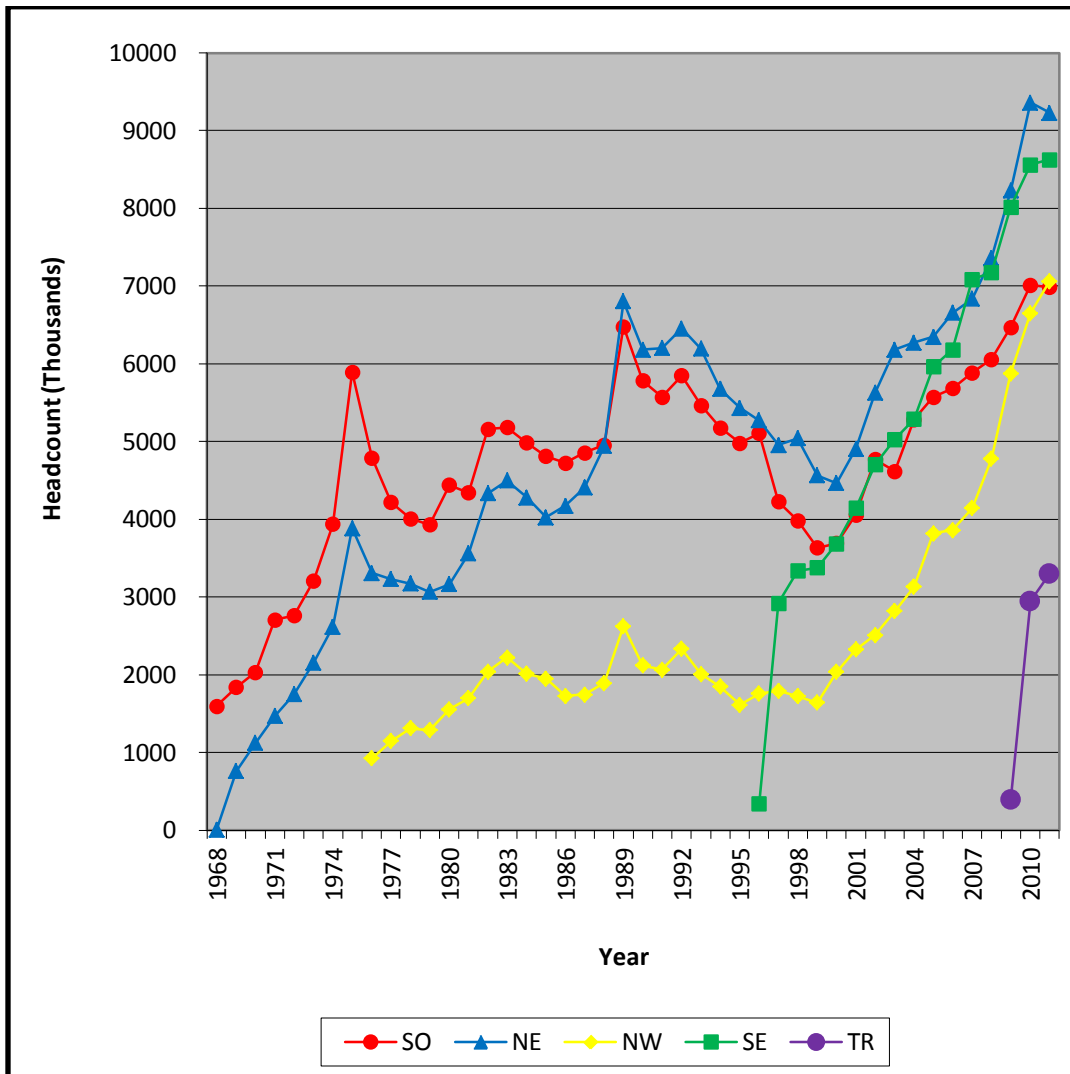
