Mr. Greenhill spoke on the Audit & Finance Committee this month where internal audit reported on processes, internal control, and compliance in accordance with regulations. The Internal Audit of the Aviation Program, verifying program costs are in accordance with TCCD policy, procedures, and federal guidelines. TCC offers an Associate of applied Science Degree in Aviation technology that is subject to FAA (Federal Aviation Administration Regulations). As well as, the Fiscal Year 2019 Internal Audit Annual Report in accordance with the Texas Government Code requires higher education institutions report on and publicly post certain information regarding the details of an approved annual audit plan and any findings or deficiencies. Overall, reporting highlighted that internal processes and controls are functioning effectively. Questions and recommendations made were addressed. Going forward, internal audit will explore/apply a tool related to integrate reporting that should further enhance oversight and monitoring of overall performances.
