The Heritage Room was founded in the 1970, inspired by the interest in history generated by the approaching Bicentennial. Northeast Tarrant county local history societies and Tarrant County history enthusiasts approached officials of the Northeast Campus with the idea of establishing a center on the campus for the collection and preservation of documents and artifacts relating to Tarrant County history – specifically to the history of Northeast Tarrant County. The Hurst Bicentennial Committee adopted the creation of this local history museum as one of its projects.
