In this issue of IR corner, data from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) were examined to produce summaries of students either working, enrolled or both working and enrolled within one year of receiving a degree or certificate, as well as students' average debt. The figures on pages 2-4 show Big 10 comparisons. (See data tables on pages 5-6).

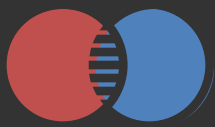
Key Findings (2016-2017 THECB Data):

- TCCD was among the top four Big 10 public two-year institutions in Texas reporting students either working, enrolled or both working and enrolled within one year of receiving a degree or certificate in 2016.
- TCCD had the fourth highest total student count (6,017) yet had the highest overall percentage (92.5%) of students working, enrolled or both within a year of graduating.
- In 2016, TCCD had the third highest amount of students that were both working and enrolled within a year at 2,422.
- Each TCCD campus, except TCC Connect which had no data to report, had greater than 90% of students either working, enrolled or both within one year of receiving a degree or certificate in 2016.
- In 2017, TCCD graduates with loans had the fourth lowest average debt among the Big 10 public two-year institutions in Texas with \$15,775.
- Graduates from Northeast, Trinity River and TCC Connect campuses reported higher average debt than the District in 2017.

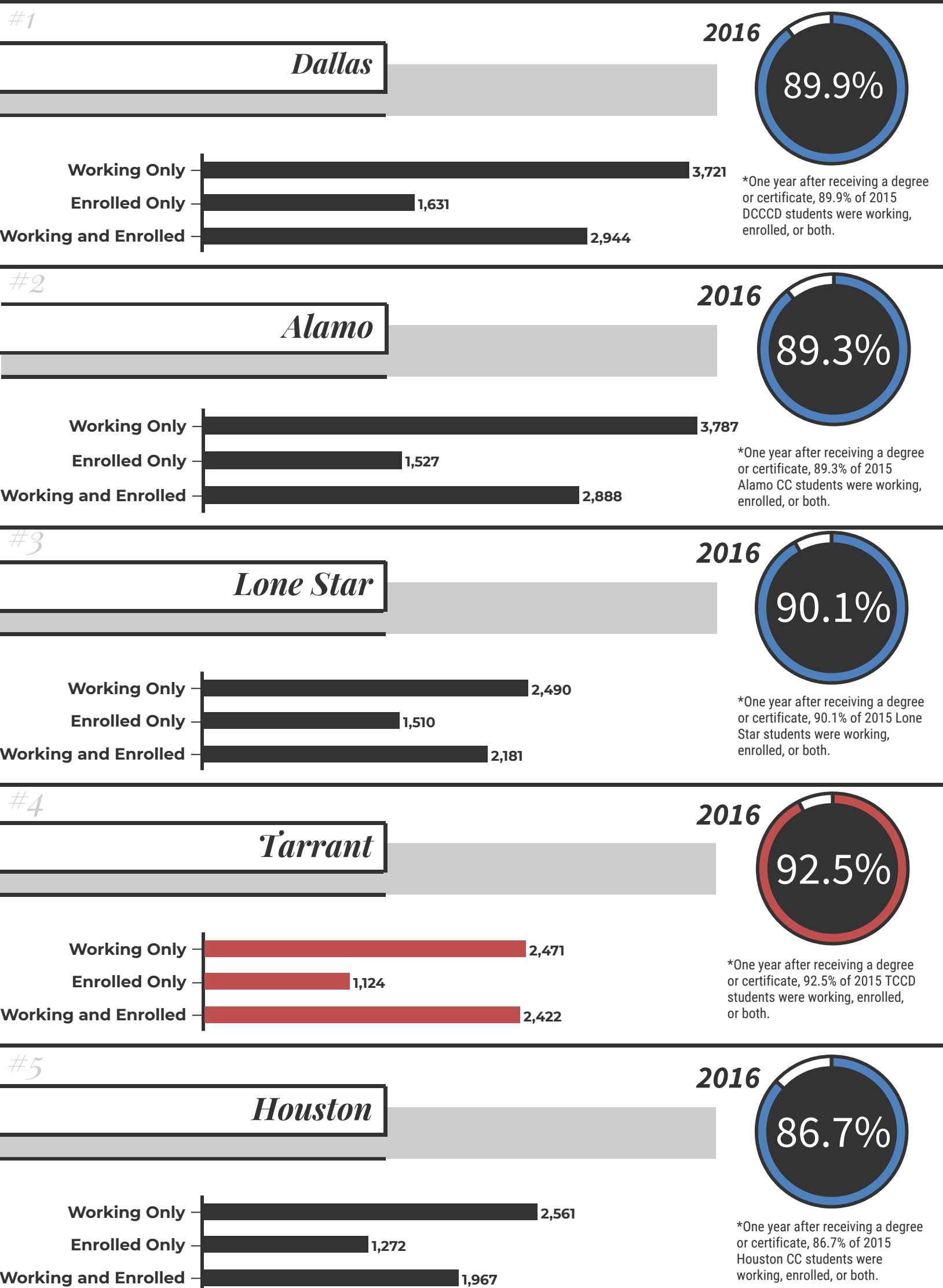

*Listed in descending order by greatest total student headcount

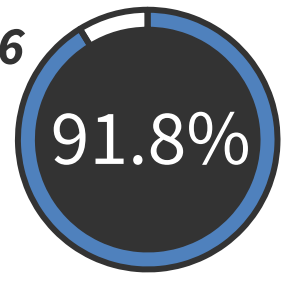

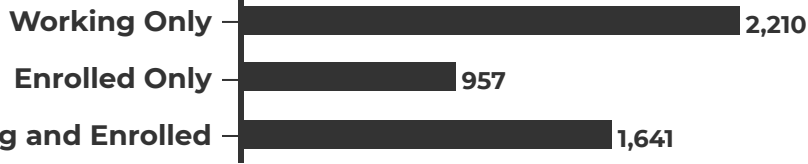

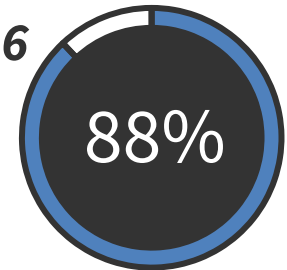
*One year after receiving a degree or certificate, 91.8% of 2015 San Jacinto CC students were working, enrolled, or both.

2016



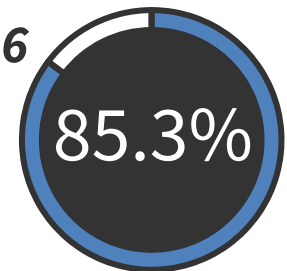

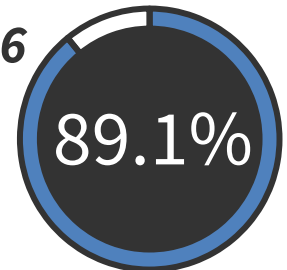

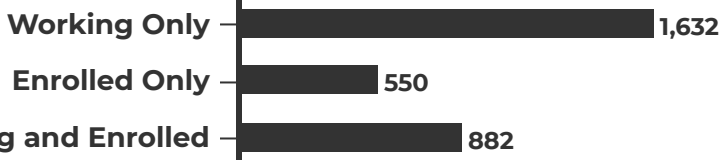

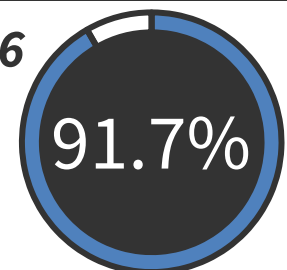
