- Support efforts between TCCD and local colleges and industries to facilitate a smooth transfer or career placement for students

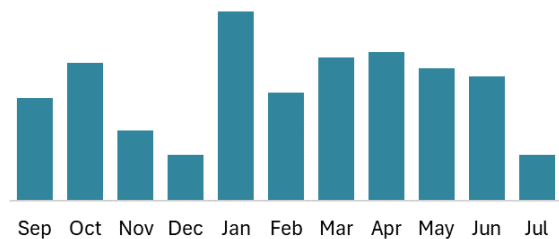

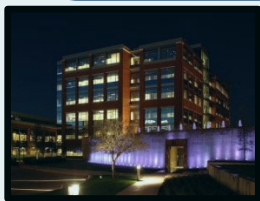


Promoting Research

IR by the Numbers (Snapshot for 2023-2024)

- Submitted 12 separate federal reports (IPEDS) annually
- Supported roughly 200 institutional effectiveness plans
- Hosted an inaugural *Data & Research Summit* with roughly 200 participants
- Released a dozen self-service PowerBI dashboards
- Published seventh and eighth issues of *IR Corner*
