TARRANT COUNTY COLLEGE NITROUS OXIDE COURSE and EXAM (0.8 CEUs) - DNTA 2000 COURSE GENERAL INFORMATION

Course Overview:

This course is in preparation for Dental Assistants and Dental Hygienists to meet Texas State Board of Dental Examiners (TSBDE) examination requirements. This course is designed to prepare the dental auxiliary to obtain certification in nitrous oxide monitoring as mandated by the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners. A comprehensive review of the general guidelines and industry standards for nitrous oxide conscious sedation will be presented. Please note you must have a current DHY license or RDA registration to apply for Nitrous Oxide Monitoring certification.

Course Description:

This online course is presented in a week-long format with course material available Monday-Thursday, with the comprehensive TSBDE certification exam scheduled for Friday, between 12:00 - 3:00 PM Central Daylight Savings Time. There will be 10 modules of instruction presented during the course supported by module discussion boards, short answer essays, and quizzes.

To receive credit (.8 CEUs), the student must pass this course by completing and submitting all assignments and quizzes in addition to demonstrating at least a 70% competency on all assignments, quizzes, and the comprehensive TSBDE certification exam. A course completion certificate to submit with the TSBDE application will only be issued if all the required assignments are completed, submitted, and graded, and the TSBDE certification exam completed with a 70% competency.
