

WHAT DOES A PT/PTA DO AT WORK?

- Restore maximum function possible after injury or illness, prevent injury and promote overall wellness across the lifespan and continuum of care.
- Injuries/illness to bones, muscles, joints, brain, spinal cord, skin (wound care), post cardiac event or those battling cancer can benefit from physical therapy.
- Examples of common physical therapy interventions
 - Strengthening
 - Balance training
 - Stretching
 - Aerobic exercise
 - Coordination and timing of muscular activation
 - Manual therapies
 - EDUCATION

WHAT IS A PTA?

- An extension of the physical therapist who works under the direction and supervision of a physical therapist.
- The nature of the role is comparable to that of a physician/physician assistant or nurse practitioner.
- Curriculum is much more compressed, but the content is mostly the same as a PT program

PTA MAY BE A GOOD CAREER CHOICE IF...

- Compassion and interest in helping people
- Lifelong learner
- People person
- Good communication skills
- Good time management skills
- Critical Thinker/problems solver: able to figure out a solution when things don't go as planned.
- Work well with others

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Visual Acuity (with corrective lenses, if needed)
- Hearing ability (with auditory aids, if needed)
- Physical ability (see next slide)
- Ability to communicate efficiently and effectively
 - Verbal, written
- Ability to manage stress and stressful situations/environments

- Lifting (in excess of 50 pounds for patient transfers activities)
- Pushing and pulling moderate loads (wheelchair, equipment)
- Walking and standing (more than 30 minutes without a break)
- Stairclimbing
- Sitting/squatting/stooping (bending at the waist)
- Reaching (above shoulder level and behind the body)
- Manual Dexterity (bilaterally functioning hands)
- Environmental Conditions (culturally diverse, high stress, fast-paced, various age groups, various diagnoses, high risk for exposure to biohazardous waste and diseases such as Hepatitis B, TB, Coronavirus, and HIV)

How many seats per application period?

Up to 32 students per cohort are invited to enroll.

Fall semester start

Cost of Attendance and PTA Salary

<\$10,000.00 for Tarrant Co. residents!

Salary dependent on the setting and geographical location of employment

BLS.gov reports \$31.66/hr an HOUR national average and \$34/hr in Texas!

\$69,090 is the annual mean wage for ALL PTA's in the DFW area. (seasoned clinicians, management, etc...as of May 2023 report)

- HESI A2
- Documentation of Experience Form/Forms
 - indicating 40 hours of observation
 - Can be obtained at >1 facility
 - Can be paid or volunteer hours
- 3 references
 - PT/PTA only
 - Must work at facility where you observed
 - Electronic Microsoft form will be sent to individual via email

- GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Transcript Evaluation
- Demonstrate Language
 Proficiency if ESL
 - TOEFL
 - IELTS

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Background Checks/Criminal History & Drug Screening

After entrance to the program.

Completed **30 days** prior to your first clinical rotation in the 4th semester

Required by clinical sites

www.ptot.texas.gov

Request a criminal history evaluation to be sure you are eligible for licensure

Immunizations

Upon Application:

- √ *HEPATITIS A
- √ *HEPATITIS B
- ✓ MMR
- ✓ Varicella
- √ Tdap (every 10 yrs)
- √ *Covid-19: 2 doses(some facilities are requiring)
- ✓ If under 22, please submit proof of MCV4 (Meningitis) to your campus registrar's office.

After entrance to program just prior to clinical rotations:

- ✓ Influenza (annually)
- ✓ TB Skin Test (annually)

*Requires multiple injections & take up to 6 months to complete. Must have at least one dose to be eligible to apply.

Other

After entrance to the program:

- CPR certification
 - American Heart Association BLS course
- Physical Exam
- Personal Health Insurance

ADMISSION RANKING CALCULATION

3 items are considered:

1. OVERALL GPA

Last 5 years of college coursework (or HS transcript)

2. SCIENCE GPA*

*BIOL 2401/2402 ONLY

3. HESI A2 SCORES

Reading, vocabulary, grammar, math only

Min of 70 required for each section

BONUS POINTS HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONS

- Documented Military Veteran (no children/spouses)
- Dual credit student with TCC
- Existing college degree

• All will receive .1 for each as applicable

IMPORTANT!

- Having the stated requirements does not guarantee admission
- Regardless of previous college coursework, it will still take 5 semesters to complete our program
- NOTE to those receiving financial aid: Taking non PTA courses ahead of time MAY reduce financial
 aid eligibility later when completing the program. Talk to your TCC financial aid office to determine if
 this concerns you and what the amount of the reduction may be. Email: financial.aid@tccd.edu
- PTA courses must be taken in the order shown in the catalog curriculum page (they are **ONLY offered** during the semester shown).
- Progression to the next semester of the program requires successful completion of ALL courses in the current semester. Courses are only offered once a year.
- Only students accepted into the PTA program may take PTA courses.

These courses must be completed according to the degree plan schedule with a grade of C or higher.

^{*}These are recommended to be complete prior to application, but not required.

PTA PROGRAM SCHEDULE

Program courses are **in person** and **usually** (not always) meet weekdays between 8am and 6pm

Clinical courses MAY require weekend hours

This is a "Full-Time" Program in terms of class time and outside of class study time requirements.

Students need to be able to commit to a **full-time** schedule for **five consecutive semesters.** Please be sure your family is on board and understands the rigor and study time required of this endeavor.

Part-time, evening and distance learning options are **not** available at this time.

What then?

- A. Invited to Top 40
- B. Not selected (you were not in the Top 40 of those candidates in the applicant pool)

Selection Into Program

Top 40 attendees are notified within a few days after the **MANDATORY** meeting.

Selected or Alternate?

Must have attended the meeting to be eligible for a seat in the program.

Up to 32 will be invited to enroll Remaining 8 will be considered alternates.

It is the reponsibility of the applicant to make sure the correct e-mail address has been provided.

*Please note that the PTA Program Director is not privvy to the status of the applicant.

PAYING FOR SCHOOL

- Apply for scholarships through the TCC Foundation now!

 - March 1-May 1 (decisions made mid-August)
- Complete the FAFSA and apply for federal loans
 - www.studentaid.gov
 - Application opens on December 1, 2024 for next academic year aid and federal loans
- Private loans: Sallie Mae, College Avenue, SoFi, etc...
- Cash flow it (not recommended to work during the program...so work a lot now and save it...)
