- Official transcripts from ALL U.S. colleges/universities attended, sent directly by the institution(s)
 - If you are in your first semester at a U.S. college/university or you are transferring from a high school or an ESL only program, you must submit a general evaluation of your foreign high school diploma/transcript.
 - OPTIONAL: A professional course-by-course or detailed evaluation of your foreign college/university coursework. If you would like your foreign coursework evaluated, visit www.naces.org or <a href="www.nace
- Financial Statement Form for International Students
- Bank statement or other proof of liquid assets confirming sponsor's ability to support the student
 - See Financial Statement Form for International Students for list of required/acceptable documents
 - Bank statements may be no more than 6 months old and must show conversion to USD, or be accompanied by a bank letter or <u>affidavit</u> with conversion.
- Copies of I-94, passport, visa, and current I-20
- Passing language proficiency scores You must meet one of the following minimum score requirements for admission. If you do not, you may qualify for our <u>Language Pathway Program</u>.
 - TOEFL Scores:
 - Internet-based (71)
 - Computer-based (193)
 - Paper-based (525)
 - o IELTS Score (Academic):
 - Overall Band Score (5.5)

The items listed below are required upon admission to TCC and before registration of classes.

- A degree plan of the major you are pursuing at TCC
- Proof of meningitis vaccination (required if new to TCC and under 22 years old)
- Create and send email via your school email address through myTCC
 - o All official communications from TCC will be sent to your myTCC email address
- Take the TSI Assessment or (if already taken) have your official scores sent to TCC.
