Financial Aid for Continuing Education (CE) students at Tarrant County College (TCC) can be funded with the Texas Public Education Grant (TPEG). CE TPEG funding is available to eligible students who meet the ***2023 USCIS Federal Poverty Guidelines (400 Percent)**. Continuing Education students may also apply for Tarrant County College Foundation Scholarships at www.tccd.edu/scholarships

*TCC Student Financial Aid Services may make an exception on a CE application if the applicant exceeds the Annual Income published on the 2023 USCIS Federal Poverty Guideline.

Texas Publication Education Grant (TPEG) Awarding Criteria

- ❖ TPEG Funding is available for state formula-funded classes. State formula-funded classes are **career or occupation courses**. They can be identified by the 4th character in the course rubric (i.e., ACNT-1002). All course rubrics with a letter other than "X" (ARTX-1018) in the 4th character are approved for state funding and are eligible for TPEG Awards
- ❖ Register for an eligible state formula-funded class, career, or occupational course
- ❖ You can register online through [MyTCCTrack](#) or in person at your campus' Admissions and Registrar Office. Learn more about [how to register for CE courses](#).
Payment is due at the time of registration. If you are approved to receive a CE TPEG Grant, you may be eligible for a refund
- ❖ Students who have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have been awarded aid for credit courses **ARE NOT** eligible for CE TPEG during the same academic year
- ❖ Students may be awarded up to \$533.00 per semester. The annual Maximum is **\$1,600.00**
- ❖ The award is for **tuition only**. Students are responsible for remaining unpaid tuition, fees, and course books
- ❖ A student must receive a CR (Credit) Grade in 50% of the courses in which they enroll to maintain their eligibility for the next academic year. Academic Progress will be evaluated annually in August
- ❖ Submit the CE Application **with all the required 2023 Federal Tax Information** to your campus Student Financial Aid Services Department
- ❖ It may take up to **2-4** weeks to review your application.
- ❖ You will be mailed an award letter detailing your aid eligibility. Make sure that your home address and telephone number are up to date with the Registrar's Office.

Statement of Selective Service Registration Status

- Under HB 2061, enacted by the 75th Texas State Legislature, if you are currently of the age and gender requiring registration with Selective Service, but knowingly and willfully fail to do so, you are ineligible to receive funds from the State of Texas, including grant monies.
- Almost all male U.S citizens, and male aliens living in the U.S., who are 18 through 25 years of age, are required to register with Selective Service. Some non-citizens are required to register, and others are not. Non-citizens not required to register include men who are in the U.S. on student or visitor visas and men who are part of a diplomatic or trade mission and their families. All other male non-citizens are required to register, including illegal aliens, legal permanent residents, and refugees.
- If you are not registered as required, you are presently not eligible to receive state funds and should register promptly at a U.S. Post Office. A Certificate of Mailing may be obtained from the Post Office at such time that you mail your registration and may be used as proof of your application until you receive your Selective Service Registration Card.
- A false statement may be grounds for your financial aid to be suspended. I understand that under HB 2061, enacted by the 75th Texas Legislature, I must be registered with the Selective Service System according to the requirements of federal law to receive funds from the State of Texas. I further certify that I meet the Selective Service registration requirements and that the information provided on this form is true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that any false statements may void my eligibility for financial aid funds and that the information provided on this form will be used only for evaluation or eligibility for state funds.
